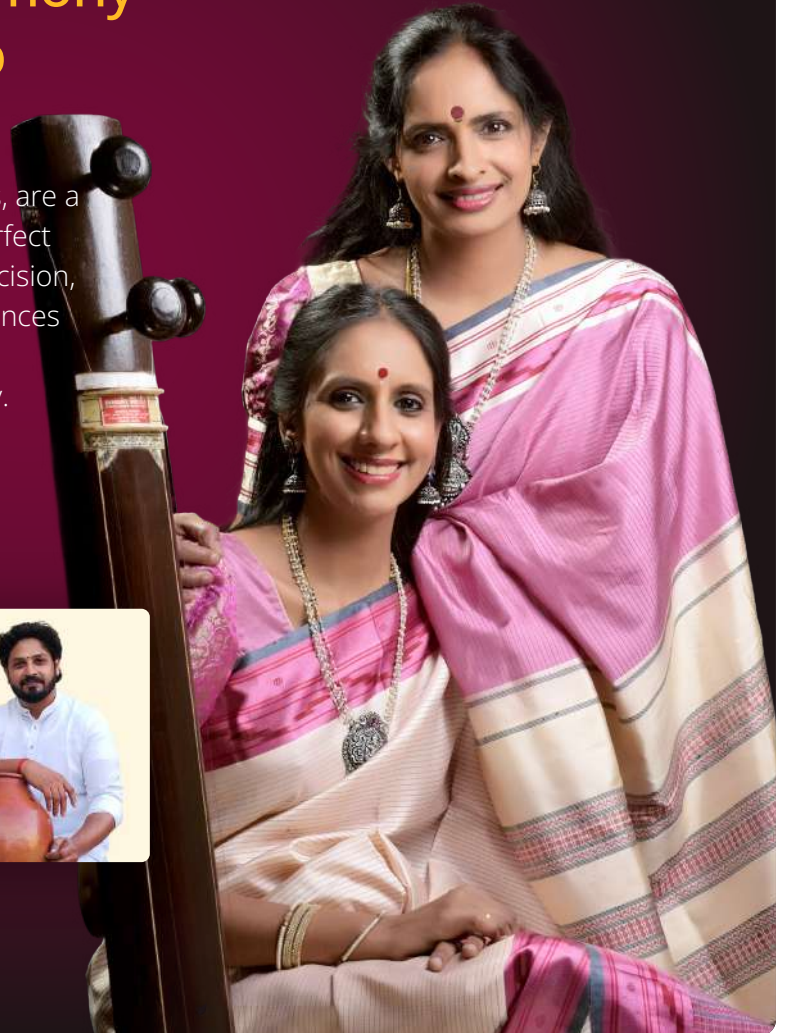
Ranjani Gayathri

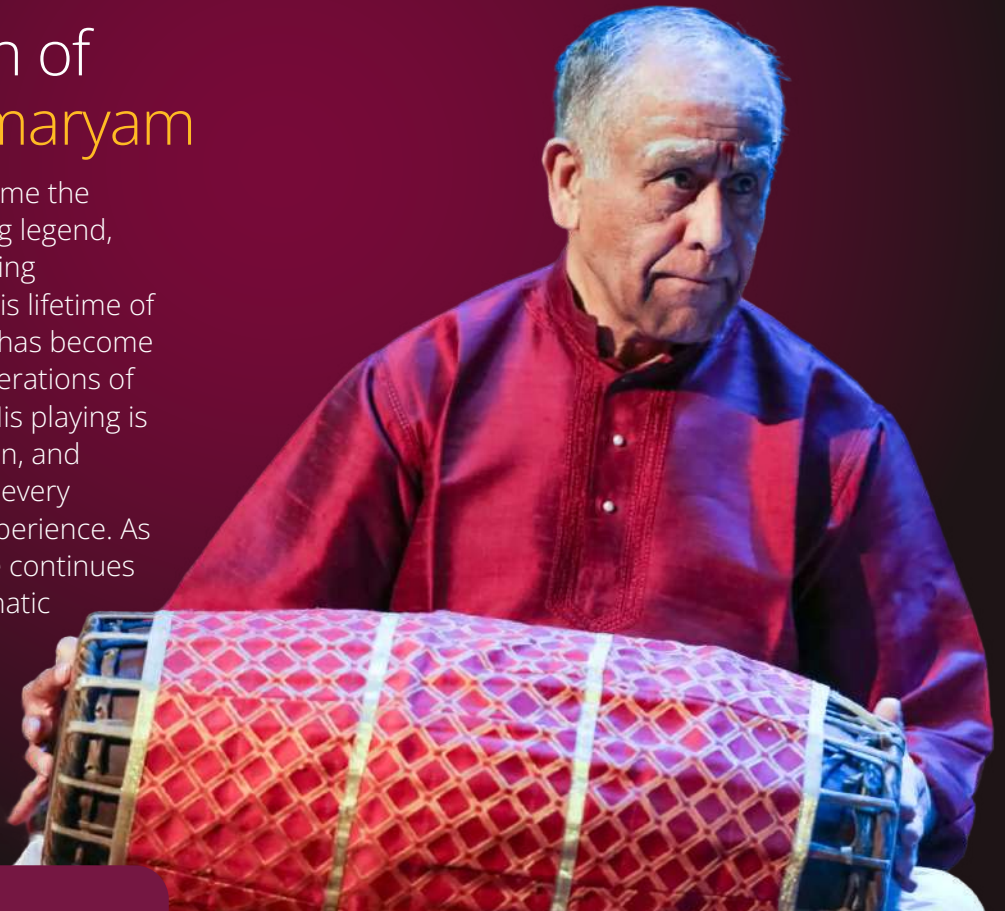
